
ICE RESCUE

OBJECTIVE:

To provide for a safe and consistent means of responding to Ice Rescue incidents.

GUIDELINE:

- 20.1** When dispatched to scenes involving persons that have fallen through the ice, all CCF/R personnel must take the time to don the appropriate PPE and equipment. No personnel will be allowed onto the ice without wearing an ice rescue suit and safety line. Only those personnel that have been trained in Ice Rescue will be allowed to go onto the ice.
- 20.2** All support personnel and staging operations must be located on solid ground and not on the ice.
- 20.3** The wearing of bunker gear and/or EMS apparel on the ice is prohibited. Personnel who violate this policy may be removed from the operation.
