Capital City Fire / Rescue is taking applications for an eligibility list for its scholarship program. The Capital City Fire / Rescue scholarship program is open to Alaska residents planning to attend University of Alaska, SE. Preference will be given to Southeast Alaska residents.

Enclosed is the scholarship application to be completed by each student applicant. Capital City Fire / Rescue has awarded 12 scholarships for the fall semester of 2009. Scholarships are renewable each semester for up to 2 years of study provided the student is fulfilling all the requirements of the program. This scholarship program requires participants to be live-in firefighters with Capital City Fire / Rescue. We currently have 3 vacancies in the program. We are filling these vacancies for the 2012 spring semester. Those selected for the 2012 spring semester can continue in the program.

A panel of judges will select the winners based on each student's future potential to contribute their knowledge and talents in Alaska. In addition, each student's service to their community, service to their school, and school achievements, and will be taken into consideration. Applicants selected from the review process will be invited to participate in interviews on December 19, 20, or 21, 2011. Interviews may be done via teleconference.

Along with the application form, students are asked to include in their scholarship package a letter of application, an official high school transcript, letters of recommendation, a criminal background check, a driving record, media release form, and a health screening form. It is important that all these be submitted with the application.

Capital City Fire / Rescue Scholarship Program

Purpose:

Capital City Fire / Rescue received under the FY 2008 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant. This grant was issued to build our number of volunteer and live-in firefighters by encouraging University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) students to join the department with tuition and fee reimbursement. Students may pursue any major but will be required to complete certain benchmark courses set by this program such as Emergency Medical Technician and Firefighter I.

Funding:

A total of 12 scholarships will be awarded to students attending UAS. Housing will also be available at no cost as part of the live-in program.

Distribution

The scholarship funds for tuition and fees will be disbursed through UAS. Scholarship money will be awarded for 16 credit hours per person per semester with an additional two hundred fifty dollars for fees. Students will also receive compensation for incident response.

Criteria:

Alaska State Resident

High School Graduate or GED

GPA of 2.5 or above

Accepted as a full time, degree-seeking UAS Student (12 or more credits)

18 years of age by the beginning of the 2012 spring semester.

Ability to cover station duty and respond to incidents at least 10 shifts a month

Valid Alaska Driver's License

Physically able to perform the duties of firefighter

Firefighting is a physically challenging profession. A firefighter wearing personal protective equipment including a self contained breathing apparatus is carrying an additional 75 lbs of weight. Activities wearing this equipment are fire suppression using water-filled hoses, forcible entry, search and rescue, and laddering buildings.

- Attendance Record (if graduating in 2010)
- Criminal background history. (State of Alaska Records and Identification 465-4343).

- Health Screening Form. If a candidate is unable to obtain a health screening deadline, we will accept a scheduled date for the screening.
- Release Form for Media Advertisement
